

Corporate Social Responsibility commitments: Dream Yacht aims to convert its entire fleet to electric propulsion

The first yacht charter company to make a concrete commitment to greener sailing and a more sustainable future for the leisure boating sector, **Dream Yacht is gradually integrating electrically-powered yachts into the fleet with 22 new vessels** (10 sailing catamarans and 12 Dufour monohull sailboats). The first electric catamaran (Fountaine Pajot Aura 51 Smart Electric) was commissioned in Italy in summer 2023.

Dream Yacht's ambition: to offer a range of 100% electric carbon-free catamarans, and thus to become the leading company in electric yacht charters.

At the cutting edge of technology, Dream Yacht's electric yachts capture and store solar, wind and hydroelectric energy during the charter for more responsible on-board consumption and quieter sailing.

/ AUSTRALIA, WHITSUNDAYS

Although located in the tropics, the Whitsundays have an excellent climate because they are cooled by trade winds for most of the year. The waters are protected by the Coral Sea and Great Barrier Reef, and most islands are surrounded by a fringing reef system. The Whitsunday Islands have enough anchorages to keep you busy for months of happy cruising. Nara Inlet is our recommended first night stop. Nara is easy to reach and its waters are sheltered so you will have a comfortable first night as you get used to the boat. There are several anchorages and moorings to choose from. Stonehaven is popular, and if you are adventure minded, there are waterfalls to explore.

The eastern wing, Grand-Terre, features Pointe-à-Pitre, the island's biggest city and center of tourism. The western wing, called Basse-Terre, is less developed and dominated by an impressive national park. A narrow channel called the Salt River separates the two halves of the island.

Sailing Corsica may get you closer to Napoleon's birthplace, now the Maison Bonaparte Museum, but this cultural bounty competes with the wonder of the UNESCO Scandola Nature Reserve.

La Paz sits at the end of Mexico's Baja California Sur peninsula, which is the second-longest peninsula in the world and separated from Mexico by the mesmerizing Sea of Cortez. If you want a vacation with total relaxation and the chance to see whales, swim with sea lions and eat high quality, tangy seafood then sailing La Paz, Mexico, is ideal. The Sea of Cortez is legendary among divers, sport fishers and those seeking an authentic, unspoiled sailing vacation among the stark contrasts of tranquil turquoise coves, pristine deserts and rugged mountain ranges.

/SEYCHELLES

The Seychelles are an impressive destination for a yacht charter, with gorgeous tropical islands, sandy beaches and imposing granite rocks polished by the relentless waves of the Indian Ocean.

They are known for giant palm trees and the famous coco de mer coconuts and turquoise inlets fringed with lush green takamakas shading fine, white sand beaches. These islands deserve the label, "paradise". The Seychelles is where Dream Yacht Charter began and for good reason, as this is one of the most beautiful destinations on the planet.

Of the 115 islands that make up the Seychelles archipelago, the 41 Inner Islands constitute the oldest granite islands on earth, while the 74 low-lying reef islands radiate tropical paradise.
